

NANTWICH SHOW - USEFUL INFORMATION

DATE OF SHOW

- Wednesday 31 July 2024

OPENING TIMES

- Car Parks open at 8.15am
- Pedestrian Gates open at 8.30am
- Last admission is 4.30pm (free entry from 4pm)
- Trade stands can begin to pack up at 5.30pm
- Movement of vehicles will commence at 6pm

LOCATION

- The showground is at Reaseheath Old Hall, Wettenhall Road, Nantwich, Cheshire, CW5 6EL. Use this postcode for most car parks. [Google Map](#)

CAR PARKING

- There are TWO Car Parks, both on Wettenhall Road, CW5 6EL
- Car parking is limited so please car share, walk or use the shuttle bus as much as possible
- Car parking is free but we do encourage you to consider popping a donation in our collection buckets for the nominated charity
- All cars are parked at your own risk, parking is all on grass so please drive slowly and may not be suitable for very low suspension vehicles
- Cars must be removed by midday the following day or will be towed away

CAR PARK D (Pink) **what3words location: indulges.blunders.tend**

- will be open from 06:00 for EXHIBITORS (Pigeons, Eggs, Floral Arts) and ATTRACTIONS in the Countryside area.
- From 08:15am for public and members
- Members parking is to the left and you will only be admitted if you have your PINK car pass clearly displayed. If you purchased your Members tickets after 16 July you will not receive a car pass but arrive before 10am and you won't be far from the gate!
- Blue badge parking is available here also, follow signs once on field.

CAR PARK A (WHITE) **What3words: sounding.marine.ramming**

- This is our overflow car park and located on the bend of Wettenhall Road. DO NOT USE IF DISABLED OR AN EXHIBITOR

CAR PARK B (BLUE) **What3words: upwards.greyhound.grinning**

- This is TRADE and ACCESSIBLE parking ONLY - you MUST display a BLUE BADGE or TRADE car pass.

SHUTTLE BUS

- There are two stops for the shuttle bus:
 - Nantwich Town Football Club, Waterlode, Nantwich CW5 5BS
 - Nantwich Bus Station, Beam Street, Nantwich, CW5 5GE
- Buses will run from 08:00 - 18:00
- Parking up to 150 cars is available at the football club for £2 cash or card (money goes to Nantwich Town FC)
- Drop off (and pick up) is Entrance 4 of Reaseheath College, The Green, A51.
- On arrival, please follow signage and walk through campus (5mins).
- Donation buckets will be onboard in aid of our nominated charity, please give generously

BICYCLE RACK

Follow the Car Park A sign to enter the campus, turn right and bike racks are in front of the Platt Halls of Residence

GENERAL TICKET SALES

- Tickets are free for children age 4 and under
- Child tickets are for 5 - 17 year olds (when accompanied by full paying adult)
- 16 and 17 year olds without an adult accompanying them will need to pay full adult price

Advance tickets must be purchased before 23:59 on 25 July

- Adult Advance - £18
- Child Advance - £8

On the Day tickets from 00:00 on 26 July

- Adult Gate - £20
- Child Gate - £10

Tickets are non-refundable if the event goes ahead.

CARERS AND DISABLED GUESTS

ONE registered carer allowed free of charge with a disabled person.

Purchase your ticket online at the discounted rate and to gain free entry for the carer on the day, you will need to present one of the following at the gate:

- Allowance Book or Letter confirming Entitlement to Disability Living Allowance (DLA), or Personal Independence Payments (PIP)
- Attendance Allowance or Carer's Allowance letter of award
- Incapacity Benefit books or confirmation letter
- Certificate of Visual Impairment (CVI) or BD8.

Alternatively, as a carer you will be required to show either:

- The National Disability Card
- National Carers Card

If you are not able to show any evidence you are registered disabled or a registered carer, you will be asked to pay the full ticket price on the day.

Please note that the show is held on a field and we can't guarantee the condition of the surface. For that reason some areas might not be suitable for a wheelchair.

There is priority parking for blue badge holders but it is on a first come basis. See showground map for details

CONCESSIONS

There are no ticket concessions other than allowing ONE registered carer in for free, when accompanied by a disabled visitor (see above).

REASEHEATH STAFF AND STUDENTS

You have complimentary entry after 3pm with your lanyard unless you are taking a day off to volunteer at the show or attend at the usual ticket price.

MEMBERSHIP

Available online until the day of the show but if you book after 16 July you will not receive your car pass so arrive early to Car Park D (Pink) and show ticket.

- Fast-track entry at pedestrian gates
- Entry to Members Enclosure, Garden and Bar (ringside)
- Members car parking
- Complimentary tea and coffee all day in Members
- Complimentary programme on arrival
- Option to purchase Members Lunch (before 20 July)
- Membership (including entry) costs
 - £30 for adults
 - £15 for 5-17 year olds

CHILDREN

- Entry fee for ages 5-17 years old. 4 and under are free.
- We have lots of children's activities, please pick up leaflet on arrival
- We have green wristbands for you to write your mobile phone number on and place on child - please ask at gate

BABY CHANGING & FEEDING FACILITIES

- Baby changing & feeding facilities are located at the Churches Together stand (next to Nantwich Town Council) near to the Nantwich Gate
- Other Baby changing facilities are available in the cubicle toilets around site

LOST & FOUND CHILDREN

- Lost children will be looked after by our first aiders, the Staff Solutions Group. If a child (or other vulnerable person) is found, or reported lost, immediate contact should be made with the Staff Solutions Group or any show steward, show security or the police and the Staff Solutions Group personnel will make their way to you. Once reported people should wait until Staff Solutions or the police arrive.
- Lost and found children will be looked after in the purple LOST CHILDREN tent next to Secretaries Office.
- Please can we advise you to write your phone number on our green wristbands at the gates

CASH FACILITIES

- Please note there is no cash machine on site. However, we have facilities on the gates to take card payments for ticket entry.
- We are offering LIMITED cash-back from the Secretaries Office next to the Members marquee. This will be denominations of £20, £50 and £100 and carry a £2 charge.

LIVESTOCK AREAS

This is an agricultural show featuring animals from local farms, they are not necessarily trained to deal with the public so please be mindful at all times around them.

- Do not feed the animals
- Do not touch the animals unless with the permission of their owner
- Do not lead dogs anywhere near the animals
- Do not use raised voices or loud toys around the animals
- If an animal breaks loose - DO NOT APPROACH - our livestock people will deal with it.

PHOTOGRAPHY

- We have a number of official event photographers and videographers attending the event. If you do not wish to be photographed, please avoid them.
- We have yellow smiley face badges to pick up from Secretaries or from the photographer if you do not wish to be photographed.
- If you think you have been captured, please approach the photographer and they will be happy to delete the image.
- All of our photos and videos may be featured on social media, press and future print literature.

DOGS

Dogs are allowed on the showground as long as they are kept on a lead at all times. Please note that dogs are not allowed in the livestock areas or the food hall. Water bowls will be placed around the showground and cooling off paddling pools will be located in the Countryside area. Please clean up after your dog and use the bins provided.

DOG SHOW

There will be a fun dog show in the Countryside arena at 11.15am and 4pm - please register online or on the day by 10am

SHOW VET

- Nantwich Farm Vets are our Livestock vets
- Eden Vets are our small animal (dog) vets and located in Countryside

FIRST AID

This is provided by the Staff Solutions Group. First aid post is situated next to the Secretaries Tent.

FOOD & DRINK

- There is an excellent variety of refreshments available across the showground. You are also welcome to bring your own picnic (no alcohol) with you.
- There are a number of seating areas around the site but a picnic blanket is advisable if busy

NON-MEDICAL EMERGENCY

Please report to the Secretaries Tent or speak to a Chief Steward.

TOILETS

Toilets are situated all around the showground. Facilities for disabled visitors are also available at these points.

WATER

There are several taps around the showground providing drinking water for you to refill water bottles.

VOLUNTEERS

If you are interested in any type of volunteering at The Nantwich Show then we would love to hear from you. Roles are varied, some are just on the day like marshalling, litter picking and selling programmes. Other types of volunteering includes helping with admin, marketing or sourcing sponsorship to setting up and breaking down the event or running an area on the day.
